

HISTORY OF THE DALLAS ARTS DISTRICT FOUNDATION FUND

The Grants Fund was established by a generous donation by the Crow Family Foundation

Over the past three decades the Dallas Arts District Foundation has awarded over 430 grants totaling \$1.2 million to Dallas arts and culture organizations.

ELIGIBILITY

***One or both of these are required:

- 1 Your organization is a 501C3
- 2 You are an approved artist through the Office of Arts & Culture

** This is a requirement:

(3) Your proposed event must take place within the Dallas Arts District




REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

IRS Letter of Determination or Approval Letter for OAC Artists
Proposed Budget (Please use the template in the application and save with your organization's name)
Contract or approval letter for venue in the Arts District
3 images
1-min video or portfolio with images in one file
2 graphic images, ie: playbill, social media graphic ***Any changes to the scope, dates, or venues of the proposal must be approved in advance by DADF

The Application Portal

- New Applicants will be prompted to sign up for a new account to complete the application.
- Previous Grant Applicants can use their original email address to access the portal.



The Application Portal is Through Wizehive

If Selected: Final Report



If selected, you will be required to submit a report no later than 30 days after the date of your event. The report must include the following:

- 1.Project Summary
- 2.Three Benchmarks that align with the Cultural Plan
- 3. Audience/Project Demographics
- 4.Include Data from Project
- 5.Upload website link, print, and digital collateral where DADF logo is displayed
- (Please upload a link where our logo is shown and shows event/project details)
- 6. Actual Project Revenue and Expenses

FAQ's

- 1. Are only organizations located in the City of Dallas eligible? **Yes.**
- 2. Is there a minimum number of years required before I may apply?

 No.
- 3. Are Organizations a part of the Dallas Arts District eligible?

 No, organizations that are stakeholders are not eligible.
- 4. Does my project need to occur in the Dallas Arts District?

 Yes
- 5. Does the project budget need to exceed the maximum grant request? Yes, requests cannot exceed more than 50% of the budget (the recommended amount is 25%).
- 6. How soon can my project start?

 Any time between January 1, 2024, and must be completed before December 31, 2024
